## **Most Excellent Gran Master**

### **Excellency the President of the Supreme Council**

#### **Excellencies, Distinguished**

To belong to an order of chivalry in the third millennium, means to protect and defend those cultural and ideological values, rooted in the Christian Faith, and live according the Holy Gospels for serving in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The globalization cycle tends to make us forget our roots and identities, especially for people living in the so called industrialized societies.

Despite the establishment of United Nations, despite the Declaration of Human Rights or what is stated in all the national constitutions of the world which solemnly affirm the equality between peoples, today we have to face an ever-deepening gap between wealth and poverty.

This is because today the rich countries prefer to preserve their own interests as institutions instead of operating for the common and universal good. Today, the Western and European countries, traditionally Christian, tend more and more to strengthen their economic and military power or to concentrate themselves in protecting their financial profits at detriment of the poorest countries of the world that become more and more poor, more and more deprived of democracy and freedom; in these countries, suffering from atrocities due to endless and forgotten wars, people are starved and thirsty. In these countries infant mortality rate is around 35% in the first five years of life; in these countries every year about 2,000 women die to give birth to a son; in these countries one dies for the same disease that in Western countries are cured with simple aspirin.

We have the fortune to live in our developed countries but we have the duty, as Christians, to share this good fortune with those less fortunate than us.

We must ask ourselves a question: what does it mean today to be a real knight? Can our knighthood be reduced to a mere historical interest? The only answer we can give is visible through our actions; actions performed by men and women having a firm faith, who are not afraid to express and protect their strong Christian beliefs, that are individuals capable of being charitable, humble, honest and obedient, able to fight against injustice in order to reaffirm the ethical principles of solidarity too often trampled and forgotten.

The Order of Saint Lazarus of Jerusalem is composed by these men and women strong in their Faith but at the same time humble, obedient and respectful so that to actively contribute to the defense of Christian values and be operational instruments for the achievement of the common good not considering their ability in changing themselves into peace-builders.

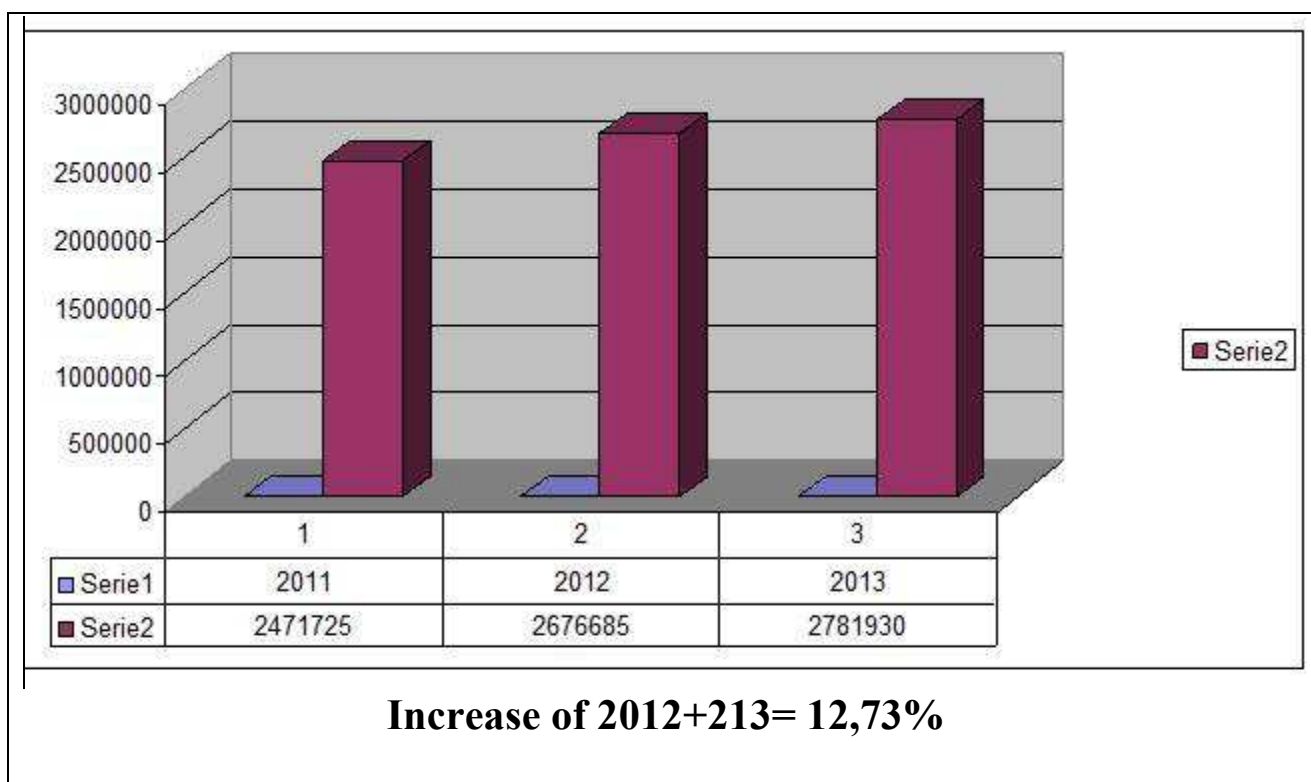
To pursue these goals, we must learn to walk in a cohesive way.
